He has been the president of Turkish Association of Public Health Specialists since 2021. He participated applied epidemiology and global health management courses at CDC in Atlanta-USA and qualitative research techniques course in NewCastle University-UK. He has worked as visiting professor in the Department of Sociology in University of Alaska Anchorage (USA) in 2014 for three months and Syarif Hidayatullah University Jakarta, Faculty of Health Sciences (Indonesia) in 2023 for one month. He worked as a trainer and consultant in the "Community Oriented Primary Care" trainings organized together with the WHO Azerbaijan country office and the Ministry of Health in Azerbaijan in 2022-2023. He also graduated from Anadolu University Department of Sociology in 2019.
